The tree removal part of the AWOS project has come to a difficulty. Because this is a federally funded project and as it is managed by the DOT/BOA the removal of the trees has come under the scrutiny of the DNR. Part of the area was delineated, at some point in the past, as “Forested Wetlands”. If the tree removal changes the nature of the delineated land, a determination only the DNR can make and only during the growing season, their approval is required. Possibly not, however. Chris Egger, the BOA’s liaison with the DNR, understands our situation and is trying to expedite the process. This will probably add a couple of months to the project and will prevent us from removing the trees before winter.

The new generator is working correctly. All weekly test runs are positive and when there was a power outage at night last month, the generator ran for 4+ hours resulting in a miniscule, almost indiscernible on the gauge, drain to the LP tank.

Traffic at the Airport has been busy for October thanks to remarkably good weather.
