The BOA wants to move ahead with the design of the Airport perimeter fence this year as indicated on our Six Year Plan with installation in 2016. But since the Board has moved funds from the Airport's Designated Fund into the General Revenue for the last two years, we no longer have the Sponsor's portion of the project funding. I have therefore informed the BOA that we will not be able to proceed with this project for the time being. The perimeter fence is a project encouraged by the FAA and Homeland Security for security reasons. The users of our Airport want the fence to prevent wildlife incursions. I have had many pilots tell me that they avoid night landings here because of the possibility of deer on the runway.
