Dave Ehlen would like to formalize the lease for industrial zone lot 8 to commence May 1, 2014. His plans, at this stage, include a 30' x 64' building. His concerns are about the setback and accessibility from the road with a trailer. He knows about the need for a building permit, etc. He would like the Board's approval at this time.

The AWOS (Automated Weather Observation System) bid is planned by the BOA to be due May 22nd. Our AWOS is being bid along with systems for Washington Island Airport and East Troy Airport. The expectation is that by combining the projects there will be some cost savings. The AWOS system includes, not only on site, real time, data for pilots but qualified data for the National Weather Service as well as public access, by phone, to live weather data. This data will include, besides temperature, humidity, precipitation and wind direction and speed but also cloud cover, ceiling height and visibility. This will be more accurate and complete data than is available through, for example, weatherunderground which has data from "personal" weather stations such as the ones we have installed at the Ferry docks. This data could also be fed to the Town's website. It will be an asset not just for the Airport but a resource for the Town.
