The road crew has been doing an excellent job of keeping the Airport runways plowed and clear. I did close the Airport December 27<sup>th</sup> through the 31<sup>st</sup> due to severe icing. This is the first time since I have been Airport manager that there has been runway icing as extensive and persistent as it was the end of December. So far there has been only one taxiway light that was clobbered by a snow plow and that was just this past weekend.

Bids went out on January 15<sup>th</sup> for the AWOS site clearing and grading. Bids are due by January 29<sup>th</sup> at Cooper Engineering, attn. Brad Volker. I won't know the bid results until February 1<sup>st</sup>.

Lisa is disseminating the results of our Airport survey from last fall. Though the responses were fewer than I had hoped, the opinions were pretty much as expected.
