Re: Monthly Police Report for February 2011

During the month of January 2011 the La Pointe Police Department responded to the following:

- 14 Various Complaints/Incidents
- 2 Citizen Assist Requests
- 1 Before/After Duty Call Outs
- 1 Non-Reportable Traffic Accident
- 1 Parking Violation
- 4 Vehicle Title/Registrations
- 1 False Alarm
- 13 Civil Process Served

I have ordered a 2011 Ford Explorer through Ashland Ford to replace our 2003 Ford Interceptor. It will be a couple months before the new squad is delivered then we'll go about outfitting it. I understand that you agreed to have Auction Associates to handle selling the old squad and once that takes place the proceeds will be split equally between Ashland County and the Town of La Pointe, which generally ends up to be about \$1,200 a piece.

It appears that ice road travel is very near which means we have no control over when people come or go and history shows this can be troublesome. During ice road season we like to make our presence known as much as possible, especially on the North End, but we also rely on residents to keep their eyes and ears open and encourage them to report anything unusual as soon as possible. Property owners should make sure they lock buildings, vehicles, etc. If people know their neighbors are out of town but they see fresh tracks in the driveway, it's best to report it right away. The longer we have ice travel the more time there is for undesirables to make plans to commit theft so everyone needs to watch out for their neighbor.
