9/4/2013 Fire Department and E.M.S. were toned out at 06:10 for a fire at 3195 Big Bay Road. F/D officer William Tibble was the first to the scene. Officer Tibble radioed in visible smoke and flames, moments later he radioed to inform structure now fully engulfed. Fire Chief Reichkitzer was next to respond to the scene observing that officer Tibble was to the side of the road with the only two occupants of the house, he stated one was o.k. but the other had some injuries. Chief Reichkitzer also called to report that the structure was fully engulfed. Officer Tibble had turned off the propane tank located close to the house and xcell energy was dispatched to the scene to turn off the power. Engine 2 arrived around 06:19 and proceeded to spray water on the propane tank to keep it cool and started knocking down the flames. Ambulance 509 was next on scene, they immediately loaded patient and transported to hospital. Engine 1 next on scene, they deployed hose lines and proceeded to knock the fire down. When fire was under control they applied foam enriched water to smother the remainder of the hot spots. Three tankers supported the pumpers shuttling water from the dry hydrant located at the marina. Estimated water used was in excess of 30,000 gallons. We left knowing we would come back later for overhaul or possible rekindle. Back at the fire hall at 09:46.

9/4/2013 law enforcement watching over the scene at 3195 Big Bay Road radioed dispatch to inform the fire had rekindled. Fire Department was dispatched at 10:19. They called in town of Lapointes backhoe to pull down the remaining sections of walls to help in extinguishing fire and for safety reasons. They performed over-haul at this time. The smoldering remains were contained again, Fire-Department back in service 13:08

9/4/13 Fire Department dispatched at 16:43 for smoke at 3195 Big Bay Road. There was a few hot spots under the remaining floor, we had to dig in, extinguish and applied more foam. Back in service 18:32. Returned to hall for debriefing and monthly meeting.
