### **Roads**

- All the roads downtown were plowed with the JD 410 and TV 145 to widen.
- Winging with the grader was done on all the main roads. We will continue to wing the secondary roads to help divert water with the run off that has just begun.
- Two culverts were frozen on North Shore Road, and the steamer was put into action for the first time this year on Friday March 7, 2014.

### **Parks and Rec.**

- The floors in the shower facility at BBTP cleaned up very nicely by Arnie Mackey Construction.
- The plumbers and electricians are coming back over on March 10, 2014.
- I purchased the lumber needed for the campsite reservation holders and plan on constructing them in the coming month.

### **Trucks, Equipment and Shop**

- The 98 plow truck blew a coolant hose. We were able to get the parts from the marina and fix it quickly.
- The Grader 772CH got new fuel filters.
- The oil was changed on the steamer.
- The 2008 Ford  $\frac{3}{4}$  ton pick up has an electrical issue that is draining the battery. I've been told this has been an on going issue with this truck. I plan on taking it to a shop to have it fixed.
- Scott has moved all of his personal stuff out of the shop and we have started to clean and organize it.

### **Administrative**

- I met with Bonnie from MIWP and discussed the future goals of the MIWP and this summers' invasive species interns.
- I attended a workshop hosted by NCWMA discussing the treatment and problems regarding invasive species in our community.
- I drove to High Bridge, WI and met with Emmer Shields (Ashland Co. Hwy Commissioner) to introduce myself and to see his operation.
- The search for the mechanic and invasive species interns continue. I hope to be conducting interviews in the very near future.
