This month we have had just one transport and two other calls. We are using the van style ambulance because of weather. During the month we had Adam replace the alternator and it seems to be helping our battery issues with the ambulance.

Barb and I are going to meet soon to go over the changes we need to make our payroll system in better balance with the size of the service and the hours we put in. There seems to be a definitive difference between our everyday hours as per diem hours and our actual hours working or on a call.
