

## Madeline Island Service Report

This is the beginning of our busier season. In May and June we have had 5 runs. Four have been transports and one non-transport.

All EMT's must renew their licenses before the end of June. We now renew them on line with the State of Wisconsin.

John Carlson has passed both his written and practical exams. He joins the service on A Team and we welcome him. As soon as he receives his license he will be added to the payroll.

We have been discussing the Conceal and Carry Law and its impact on the service. Nick Nelson has researched the ramifications and has met with the Ashland Fire Department and we are looking into adopting their policies with revisions to fit our service. I know he has brought it before the town board for their comments. We will be having a training meeting next week to go over the rules and regulations of the policy. In addition we had our regular monthly service meeting.

There are several individuals that have expressed interest in training and becoming EMT's. The officers will be meeting soon to decide how to interview the candidates. If there are more than two serious candidates wishing to take the course this fall, we will have to discuss a budget and plan to decide how many we can train at one time and if the service benefits by having more than two candidates at one time.

Gary Russell has given us a new schedule of boat captains to phone after regular ferry line hours and instructions as how to proceed during their regular business hours.

I will be attending the monthly EMS council meeting at the end of the month.
