Re: Monthly Police Report for March 2011

During the month of February 2011 the La Pointe Police Department responded to the following:

- 12 Various Complaints/Incidents
 - 7 Citizen Assist Requests
 - 2 Before/After Duty Call Outs
 - 1 Non-Reportable Traffic Accident
 - 1 Parking Violation
 - 3 Vehicle Title/Registrations
 - 2 False Alarms
 - 4 Civil Process Served

I recently received a call from Ashland Ford letting me know that the 2011 squad car we ordered has begun production. They thought it would be another four to six weeks before they expected delivery. Because it is Ford's new model in police packages, I have to wait on ordering lights, cages, guards etc.. The goal is to make sure it's ready to use no later than Memorial weekend.

You are all aware of the ice crossing conditions and we will stay with our current schedule as long vehicles continue to cross. My thought are as soon as the temps rise we will see the ice go fast.

I've been told by both local suppliers that gasoline is running low. Kieth doesn't seem to think it will be a problem with what's on hand at the Town Shop but just in case, I've directed the cops to keep patrol mileage to a minimum in case rationing becomes more widespread.
