Re: Monthly Police Report for March 2012

During the month of February 2012 the La Pointe Police Department responded to the following:

- 29 Various Complaints/Incidents
 - 5 Citizen Assist Requests
 - 2 Before/After Duty Call Outs
 - 1 Reportable Traffic Accident
 - 4 Vehicle Title/Registrations
 - 1 False Intruder Alarm
 - 3 Civil Process Served
 - 4 Traffic Citations Issued
 - 3 Parking Violations Issued

The Police Departments newest hire, Joshua Novak, has successfully completed the requirements set forth by the Training and Standards Bureau. I have submitted the required paperwork to the Department of Justice and I would imagine they will act on our request at their next quarterly meeting in June. He can begin work at any time and once he gets housing issues straightened out I hope to add him to our schedule start training him in.

Since my last report, I've spoke with Cindy Dalzall, she said the Ambulance Service will not be updating the AED'S (defibrillators) they currently carry. She also felt the Federal Grant that is currently being advertised didn't apply to our situation either. As I said before, it only makes sense that the police carry the same brand as the ambulance. Cindy thought there were some people interested in helping out monetarily with the purchase of some new AED'S. I'm not certain which model "Zoll" the ambulance carries but one is about \$1,700 and the other is \$2,900. If we were to equip each squad with a unit it would amount to a pretty big chunk of change.

There is no update on the equipment grant we were awarded for the mobile video camera other than we are still waiting for the check which should arrive any day, I hope.
