During the month of November 2014 the La Pointe Police responded to the following:

November really slowed down in the number of incidents and complaints and I see this as a trend until the Ice Road appears. With the ice already formed in the bay, it could just be an early ice road year. People have already started talking about the ice caves again. If they have another big year, our winter tourism could potentially become huge again this year, as long as an ice road can handle all the traffic.

Hunting Season did not generate as much calls as in previous years. It did not look like it also generated all that many deer harvested. Only one real trespassing complaint, I will call that a good year.

We were not successful in the last grant program, no grant awarded for Drive Sober Campaign. However, another grant program is set to run from December 12 through December 20 called Booze and Belts. As in previous programs, if you already won a grant you are not allowed in this drawing, fingers crossed, this will be our last chance this year. We won't find out who gets the awards until February 2015.

I have been working with Kristian in trying to manage Lot W next to the school. I have marked all the cars there for the 14 day allowance. Every 14-15 days, we will mark them again, and cite the ones that did not move. There are vehicles with flat tires in the lot that have been there some time, this needs to change. There are plans to treat Lot S (approach parking lot) with the same diligence once the windsled season starts.
