

# **TOWN OF LA POINTE TOWN PLAN COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the Town Plan Commission of the Town of LaPointe will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, April 6, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. at the Town of LaPointe Town Hall, 240 Big Bay Road, LaPointe, WI 54850, to hear public comment regarding the following:

An amendment to Section 4A. of Craftivity, Inc.'s Conditional Use Permit. Section 4A of Craftivity's Conditional Use Permit currently states "The owner(s) and/or operator of the facility may provide beverages and snacks and arrange for meals to be provided to students, teachers, and guests participating in activities at the site."

On February 10, 2016, Craftivity, Inc., filed an application requesting a change of use permit to "retrofit storage building to be annex of barn kitchen."

On March 2, 2016, the Town Plan Commission passed a motion to approve the change of use permit with conditions, including to amend Section 4.A. of Craftivity's Conditional Use Permit to state "The owners and/or operators of the facility may provide beverages and snacks and arrange for breakfast and lunch to be provided (including preparation) on site to students, teachers and guests currently participating in on-site activities. There shall be no meals provided to anyone that is not a student, teacher or guest currently participating in on-site activities."

On March 8, 2016, Craftivity, Inc., submitted a letter to the Town of LaPointe Zoning Administrator indicating that it was in agreement with some but not all of the Town Plan Commission's proposed amendment to Section 4.A. of the Conditional Use Permit. Specifically, Craftivity disagreed with the words "breakfast and lunch" being substituted for the word "meals." Craftivity proposed that the word "meals" remain in Section 4.A. as currently written in the Conditional Use Permit and not be substituted with the words "breakfast and lunch."
