ACCEPTING WISDOT OFFER TO DEVELOP RICE STREET FEASIBILITY STUDY

Whereas: The Town of La Pointe had been awarded a federally funded, state administered 'earmark' grant to design, develop and construct an extension to Rice Street, and;

Whereas: The Town received some initial design, engineering and environmental work under the terms of the 'earmark', and;

Whereas: The Wisconsin Department of Transportation, using some of the 'carmarked', federal funding, paid for that work, and;

Whereas: Subsequently, the Town was informed that the federal government had rescinded all remaining funds of the 'earmark', and;

Whereas: The Town met with representatives of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation regarding current status and future options regarding the project, and;


Whereas: The Wisconsin Department of Transportation offered to conduct and develop, at its own expense, a feasibility study from which future options and opportunities might be undertaken, and;

Whereas: The Department believed the proposed feasibility study would provide the Town with the greatest flexibility and fulfill their (WisDot and the Town) responsibilities for the initial earmark payment;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved By The Town Board of The Town of La Pointe:






