The runway lighting upgrade project is slated to begin by the end of June. Jim Price answered my questions about whether a building permit was necessary for the 12 x 12 prefab electrical shed that will be installed as a part of this project. Because it is a part of the electrical system, not a building for occupancy, and because it has been designed and engineered for the BOA to FAA and DOT standards, and because it will be inspected by the BOA at the completion of the project, there is no need for the Town to issue a permit, etc. According to him, it is not considered a building so much a part of the electrical system for the runway lights. He said he would send an email confirming all this per our phone conversation.

The Howard Airplane Club, which had a fly-in here a couple of years ago, is planning on returning for a day fly-in sometime toward the end of July.
