The runway lighting upgrade project, BOA Project #0702-4407, is moving forward with a proposal from Cooper Engineering. The total cost projected by Cooper is 12% less than the BOA's budgeted amount from 5 years ago. This savings is due to the preliminary work done during the paving project in 2009. The placement of pull boxes and conduit, and the relevant engineering, was done at that time to eliminate the need to tear up any of our new asphalt paving. Our portion of the total cost is already covered in the designated airport fund. We'll go over the numbers at the budget meeting on Wednesday.

Last Friday Dave Dalquist complemented the Town on how well the Airport has been maintained this year. This is due, I suspect, both to the excellent work of the road crew and the improvements to the pilot lounge by Dave Donkers.
