Re: Monthly Police Report for January 2010

During the month of December 2009 the La Pointe Police Department responded to the following:

- 16 Various Complaints/Incidents
 - 3 Citizen Assist Requests
 - 1 Before/After Duty Call Outs
 - 1 Vehicle Registrations/Title Transfers
 - 1 Non-Reportable Traffic Accident
 - 1 Parking Violations
 - 1 Animal Calls
 - 3 Civil Process Served
 - 3 False Intruder Alarms

I have completed the paperwork and submitted our grant application. As I said in the last report, the process is running behind schedule so although we've been awarded the grant, it may be a while before we actually receive the money.

On December 4, I sent the Ashland Circuit Court Judge, Clerk of Court, District Attorney, Assistant District Attorney and Town Prosecutor Matt Anich a letter with enclosures of the 2009 Senate Bill 251 and the 2009 Wisconsin Act 72 that represents the enactment and publication creating a new State Statute 814.52 which will allow us to recover the ferry costs for special trips. I asked that they contact me with any questions or concerns they may have. The Clerk of Court and Matt Anich are the only people I heard from and those issues got cleared up, so I remain cautiously optimistic that this undertaking may start paying off dividends for us in 2010.
