Re: Monthly Police Report for March 2010

During the month of February 2010 the La Pointe Police Department responded to the following:

- 10 Various Complaints/Incidents
- 4 Citizen Assist Requests
- 1 Before/After Duty Call Outs
- 1 Non-Reportable Traffic Accident
- 6 Vehicle Registration/Title Transfers
- 2 Animal Calls
- 6 Civil Process Served/Attempts

I finally received confirmation regarding our DDOLUA grant status and have begun filling out the paperwork electronically. This is a frustrating process but they provide excellent assistance, I intend to get the majority of it completed within the next few weeks. Unless there is some unforeseen complication, we should expect to see some money sometime this summer. I had earlier reported in error that the recipients of this grant had no obligation to match the funds. I would like to correct that as I recently found out that this grant does require a 25% match. The good news is we already met that requirement by documenting the patrol hours spent last summer to remove impaired drivers from the roadways .

Because of the numerous burglaries residents of La Pointe suffered last winter we have taken several steps this winter to prevent any repeat performances. We also rely on neighbors/friends to report any unusual activities regardless of how insignificant they may seem. Unfortunately, this unwanted activity goes up with ice road crossing so it can be thought of as getting some of the bad along with some of the good.
