During the month of January 2016 the La Pointe Police responded to the following:

January, we have been working with the roads department in the municipal parking lots when it comes to vehicles not moving after a snow fall. As you can see several parking citations have been issued, we will continue to monitor parking lots in the town.

We have been working installing equipment for the TraCs Grant, due to delays in equipment arriving and other small obstacles, we have not finished in the time frame we had wanted to, but as of Feb 1, all equipment has arrived, and we should be able close out the grant soon. I have also filled out the paper work and will be submitting for the TraCs Software in the coming weeks.

The week of February 7, I will be attending the Wisconsin Leadership Foundations Police Chief Training in the Wisconsin Dells. I had applied for and was awarded a scholarship of \$400 to help cover the costs of this training from the Wisconsin Police Chiefs Association. This is a onetime scholarship for departments that have not attended this particular training in the past.

We would like to thank the board for their insight on a new cell tower toward the north end of the island. We receive numerous complaints the day after an incident from the campgrounds and it is usually too late to deal with the complaint when we receive it. The number one reason they don't call when they need us, "no cell service". A cell tower that covers both the Town Park and the State Park will be imperative to improving safety in those areas of the Island.

A quick update on Officer Novak, he has informed us that he responding well to his treatments and is optimistic that he will be able to come back in approximately 3-4 months! We are optimistic as well.
